Goodbye Year 6

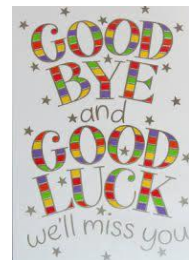
It is usual that at this time of year we will hold assemblies and celebrations with our Year 6 cohort and invite Parents and Carers in to school to join in with these.
