Arriving on time ready to learn.



Reminder of the timings of the school day. Gates open at 8.40am and close 8.50am, registration and lessons start at this time.

Years 1 to 6 children all enter through the main gate. Reception and Nursery enter through their own gates.

In Years 1 to 6, please can we ask that children are dropped off at the gate and that parents/carers do not accompany them across the playground or congregate at the gate blocking the way in. Staff are on hand at the gate and inside the building to support the children into their classrooms.

If an urgent message needs sharing please speak with a Senior member of staff on the gate briefly so the information can be shared.

Years 1 and 2 children collection is at 3.20pm and Years 3 to 6 at 3.30pm. Children are dismissed from their allocated year group gate.
