

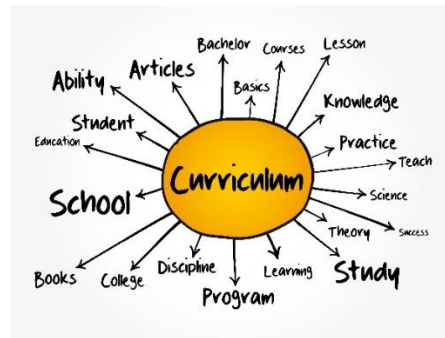

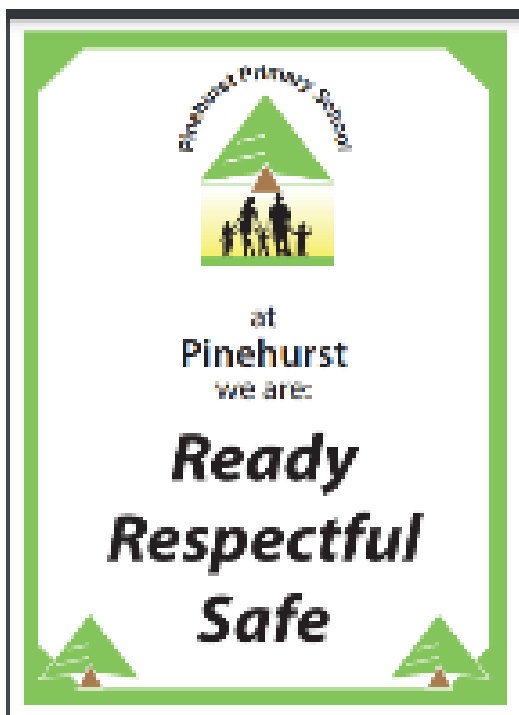
If your child needs paracetamol or other medicine, staff in school can administer it as long as you have completed a medical form at the office
