

A is for Attendance!

At Pinehurst we aim to give every child opportunities to EXPERIENCE, EXCEL and ENJOY, every single day. To achieve this, and for children to reach their full potential, excellent attendance and punctuality is crucial.



DID YOU KNOW? A two week holiday in term time means that the highest attendance you can achieve is 94.7%

Does Attendance Really Matter?

We take school absence very seriously. We identify pupils whose attendance drops below 96% and provide support to help improve this. We will contact any family whose child's attendance drops below 90% which is the persistent absence threshold. It is important that parents/carers and school work together to reduce absence and prevent legal action being taken as a result of persistent absence.

We categorise levels of attendance into red, amber and green.

GREEN - 100%. Excellent attendance above the national expected average, ideally where all children should aim to be.

AMBER - 96.7% or above. Good attendance - in line with or above national expected average.

RED - below 96.7%. Attendance below expected level.

We will monitor the child's attendance and if we do not see an improvement we will contact you. A copy of your child's attendance record is available, on request, from the school office.
