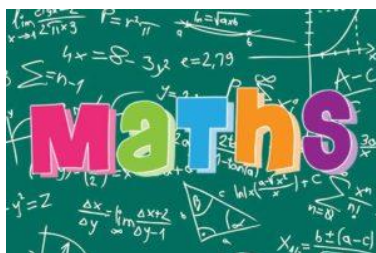

Maths teaches logic and order. You can expect a mathematical equation to have a predictable outcome, and precise steps must be followed in order to attain that result. The discipline of mind that children develop in math class can carry over into everyday life. Maths can also provide a vehicle through which critical-thinking skills are put into practice and refined. An example of mathematical critical thinking is when the children are required to explain how they arrived at a solution to a complex problem or to describe the ideas behind the steps taken to solve a problem. At Pinehurst, we start developing these skills in the children as soon as they start at our school.
