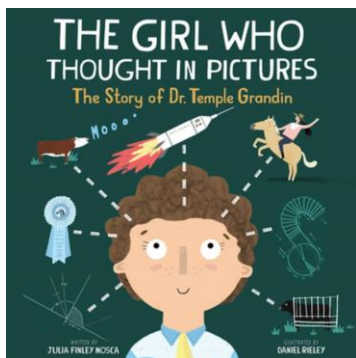
Maths Challenge
