Children will be spending the day in their new classes on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July.

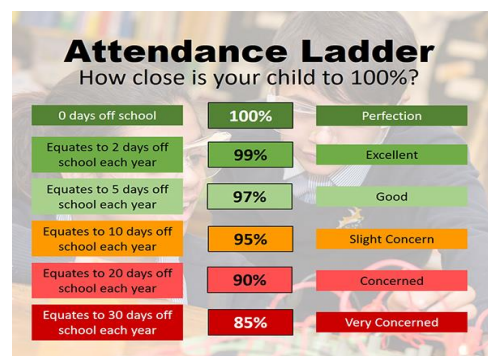
