Playgrounds

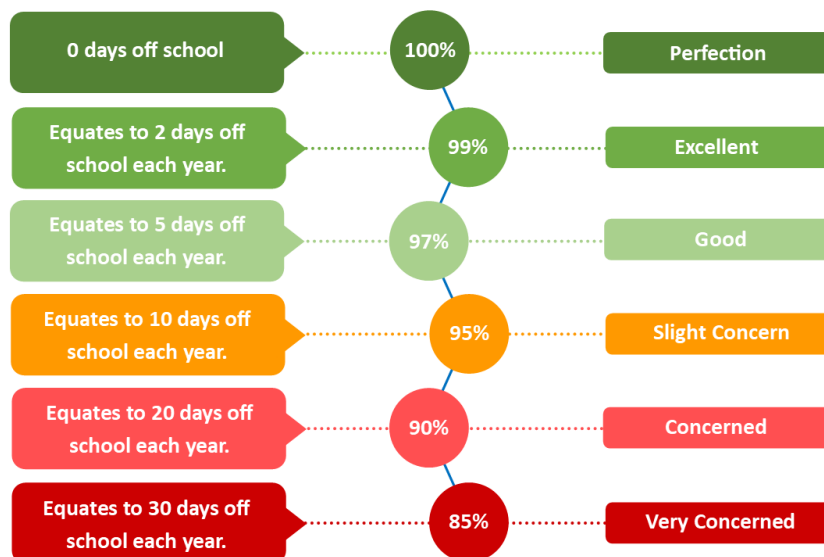
