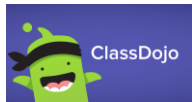

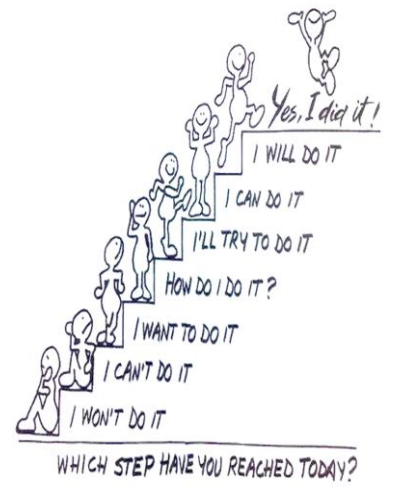

Thank you for all of your hard work with home schooling! Please remember we are not asking you to become a teacher overnight just support your child in accessing the work that we provide and asking us for help and support as and when you need it.

It's going really well and staff are working hard on any improvements they can make to make things fun and educational for you and your children.

Don't forget the expectation is for a minimum of 3 hours a day for Infants and 4 hours for Junior children - and mix it with outside exercise/fresh air, whatever the weather!

We have eight bubbles operating in school next week. We are responding to requests for critical worker and vulnerable places whilst still abiding by the rule of not asking staff to come into schools where we can manage numbers.

An Important Reminder about Positive Cases for those Children attending School

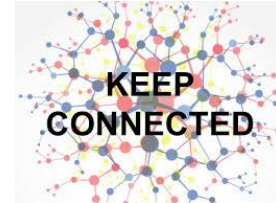
REMINDER - if your child is attending school in one of our Key Worker Bubbles and they become symptomatic or test positive school must be informed.
